## Children's Worship Notes

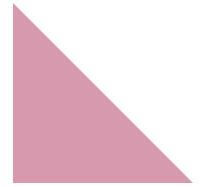
### Children's Church

### Serendipity

Cool name. Cool class. If you really enjoy reading and discussing books that look at the great leaders depicted in the Bible, this is the class for you. They have studied books on Abraham, Joseph, Moses, David and Paul. Currently, they are studying a book about Jesus.

### The Circle

The Circle will be digging into the lost practice of Hospitality using Christine Pohl's book **"Making Room: Recovering Hospitality as a Christian Tradition"** Christine D. Pohl's book has helped foster renewal of the central but long-neglected practice of Christian hospitality. ### Wednesday Night Live Adult Study

What is the purpose of life? Arranged according to doctrinal topics, the book is ideal for individual and group study, church officer training, new member and confirmation classes, and all those who are interested in Presbyterian theology.
